

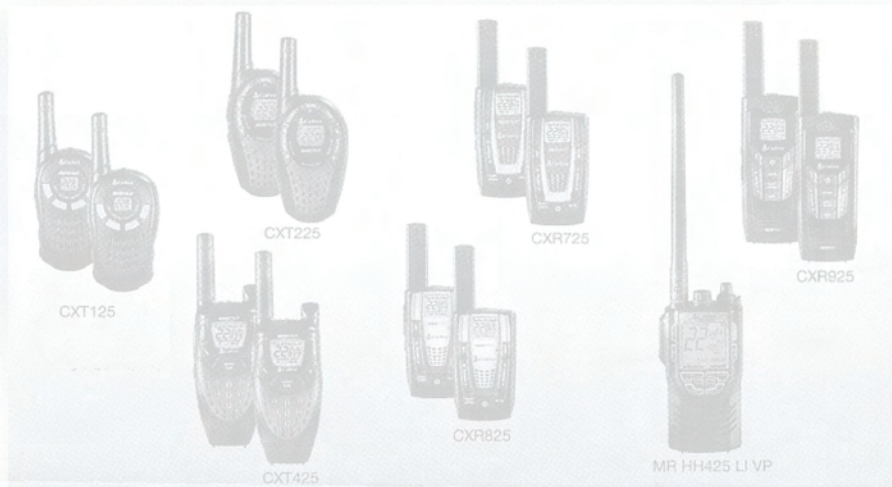
## Galley Remodeling 101

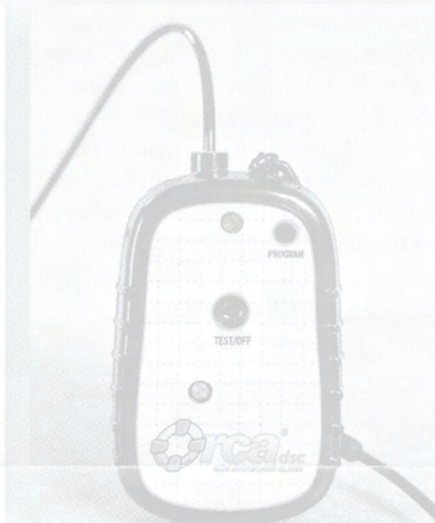
## Just a Few to Select From...

## Come and Get Me

If you're wearing the ORCADsc Man Overboard Indicator (MOBI) that's exactly what the captain or crew will be able to do. This small (3.5" x 2.27", 3.1 oz) device begins transmitting a signal to the user's VHF radio channel 70 within five seconds of submersion, and it also broadcasts its signal to standard SAR frequencies (121.5MHz).
